At that time, you may submit a statement to the Assistant Vice President for Enrollment Services indicating why you disagree with the College's decision. The Assistant Vice President for Enrollment Services will submit the Residency Form, copies of all documentation provided by you, your letter of appeal along with the College's determination to the Vice Chancellor for Legal Affairs and General Counsel.
