

MTH 2003 Uniform Final Exam Analysis

MTH 2003 uses a uniform final examination. On the average, there are between 40 and 50 sections of the course offered each semester. Generally, students do better in the fall semester. The performance in the fall semester is always stronger than in the spring as there are more entering freshmen and fewer repeaters taking the course in the fall.

A score of 0 on the exam means the student was either absent from the final, or received a W, WU/WF grade for the course

Any score below 17 means the student fails the course, no matter how well he/she was performing during the semester, therefore the designation P, indicates a raw score of 17 or above.

Each question is worth 3 points so the Grade Percentage is obtained by multiplying the raw score by 3.
