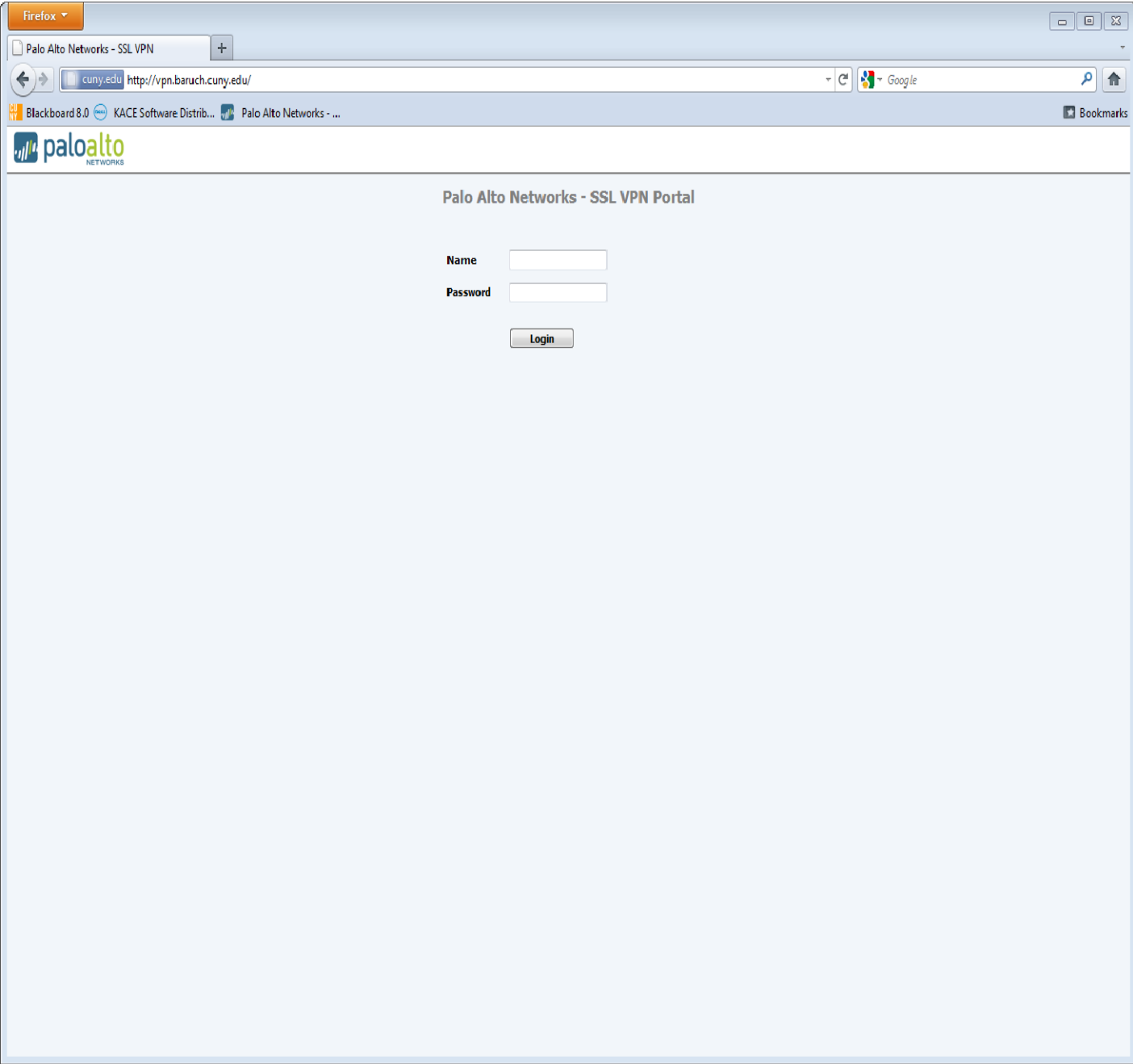


Installation Instructions for installing and connecting to the Baruch College VPN system (Palo Alto SSL VPN) - PC version

Step 1: Launch your web browser and type in the following web address:

<http://vpn.baruch.cuny.edu/> (Do not put www before the address)



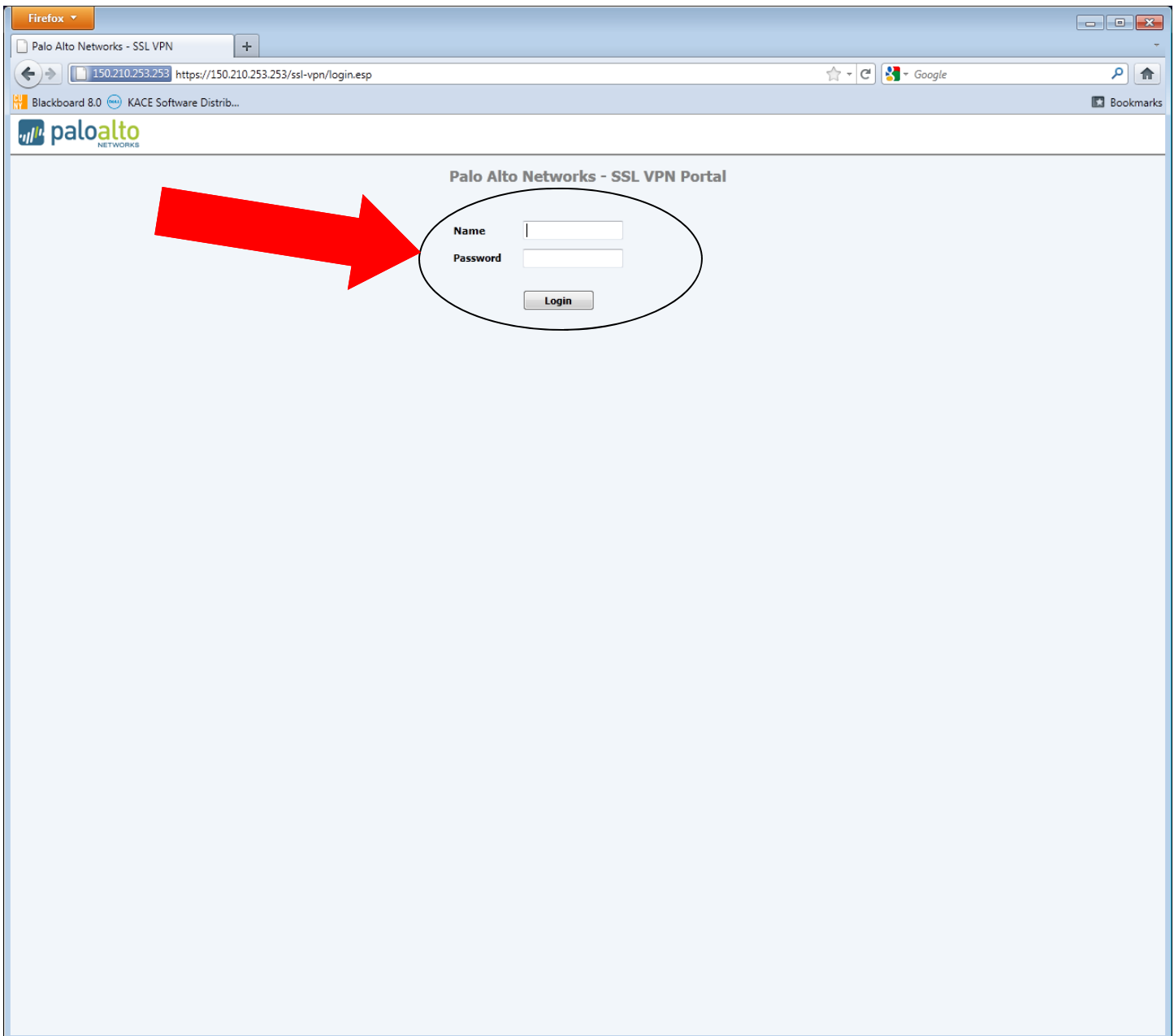
Step 2: To log into the Palo Alto web-site, enter your username with the domain first in the name field as shown below.

(e.g. bctc\bbaruch or acad\bbaruch

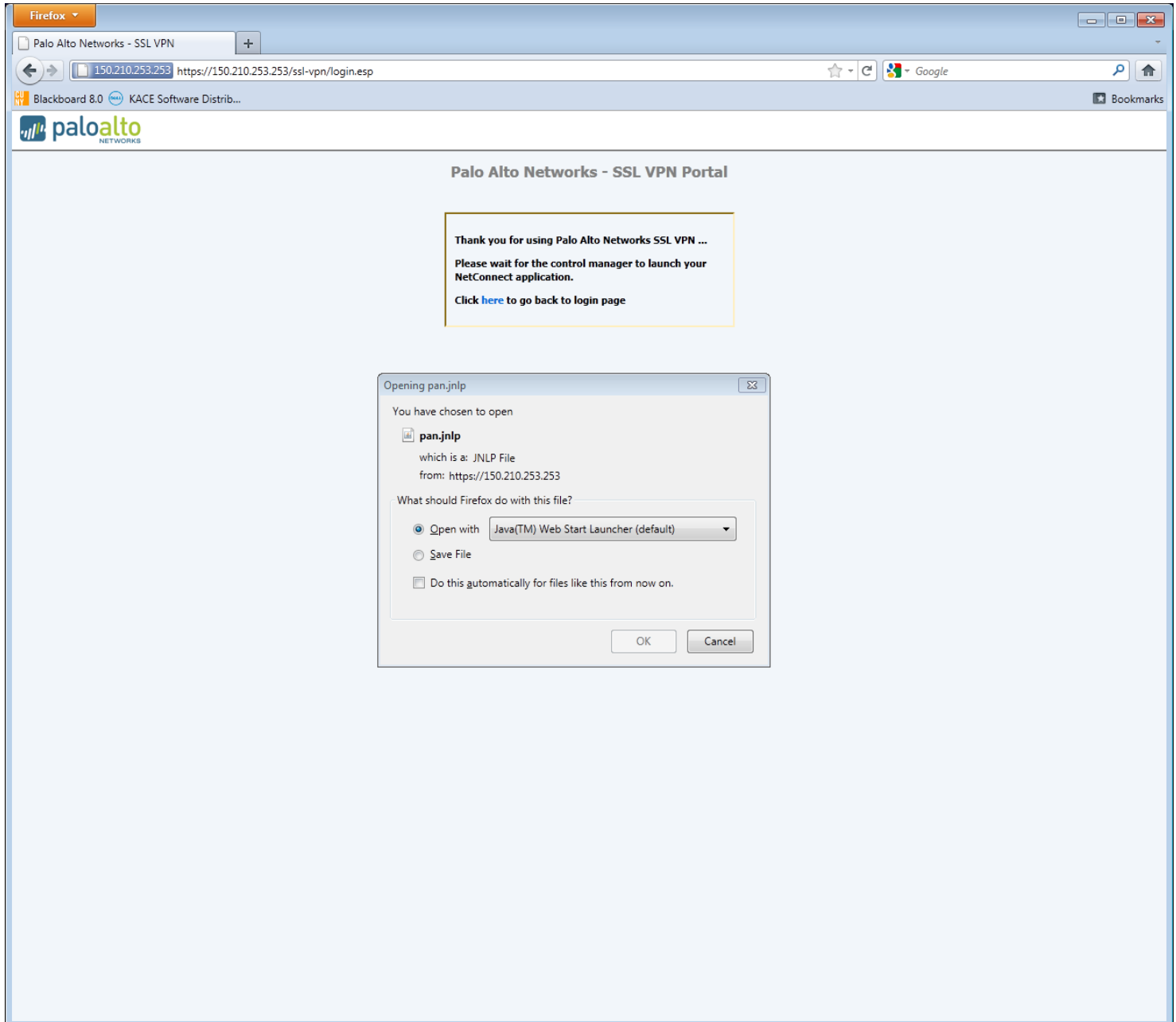
Step 3: Enter your password in the password field.

**** This is the same username and password that is used to log into your computer and check your e-mail ****

Step 4: Click the login button



Step 5: Once you have logged into the site, a dialogue box will be shown that will automatically start the installation of the software. No user action is required in this step.



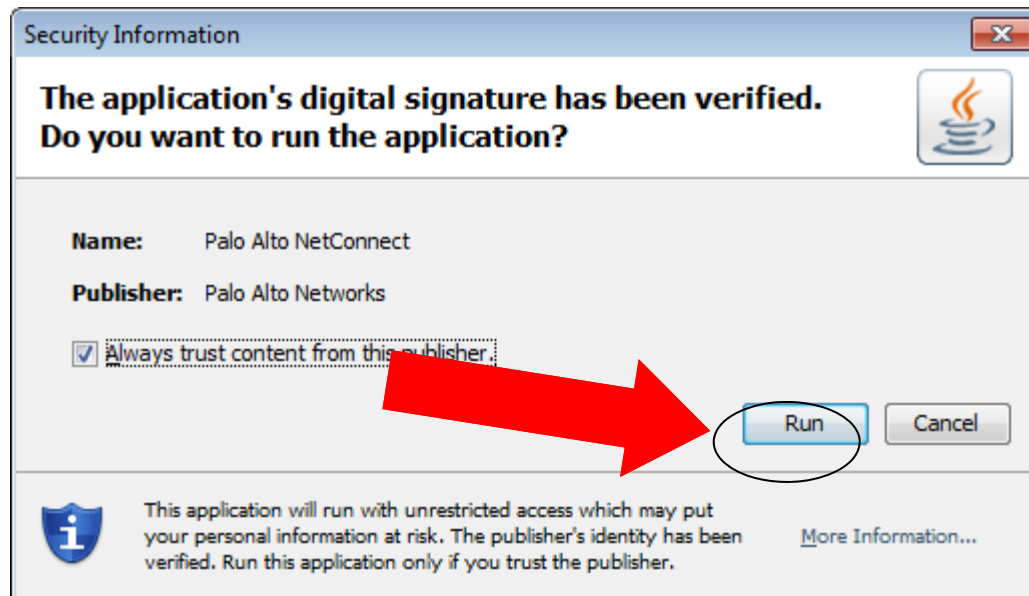
Step 6: A java window similar to the one below (depending on your operation system) will be displayed. No user action is required in this step. Proceed to step 9 below.



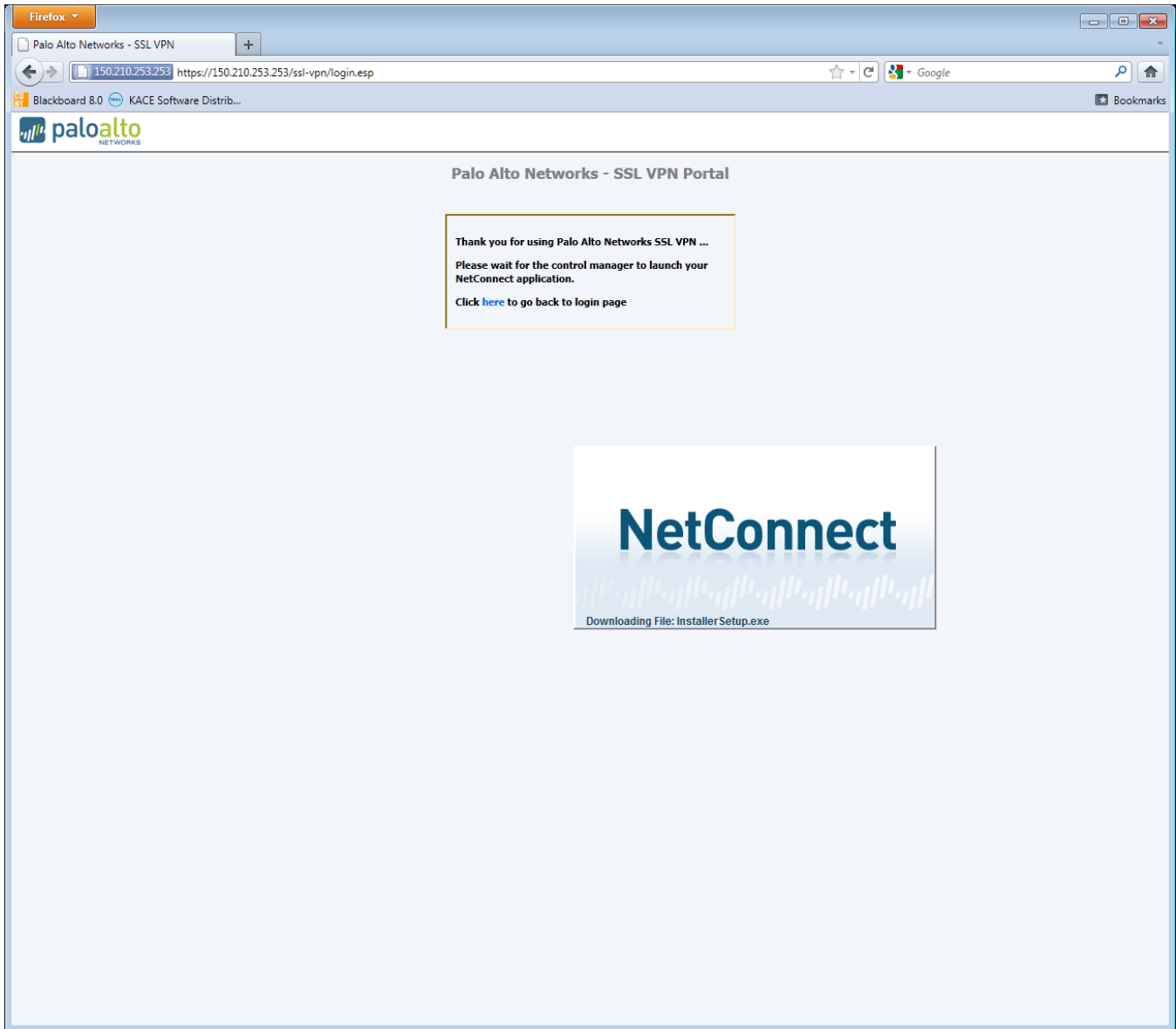
Step 7: A dialogue box will be displayed requiring you to click Yes to continue. Please click Yes. Please proceed to step 10.



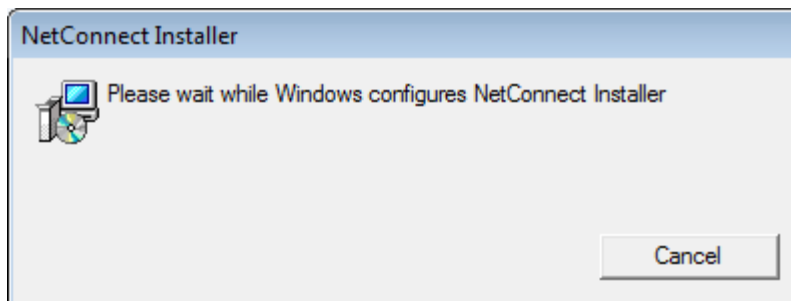
Step 8: A dialogue box will be displayed requiring you to click Run to continue. Please click Yes. Please proceed to step 11.



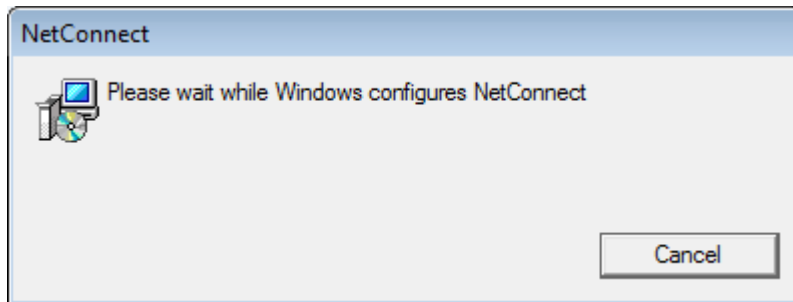
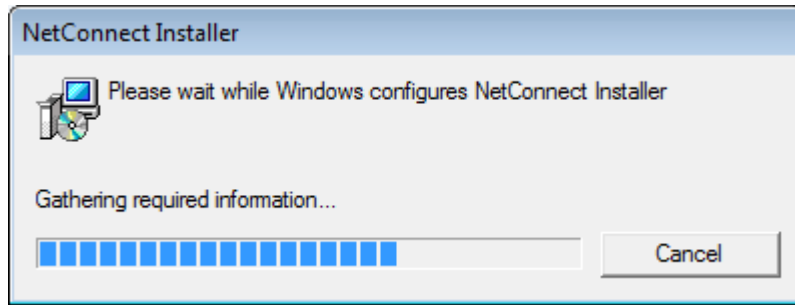
Step 9. A Net Connect window will appear on the screen as indicated below. This will begin the start of the installation. No user action is required.



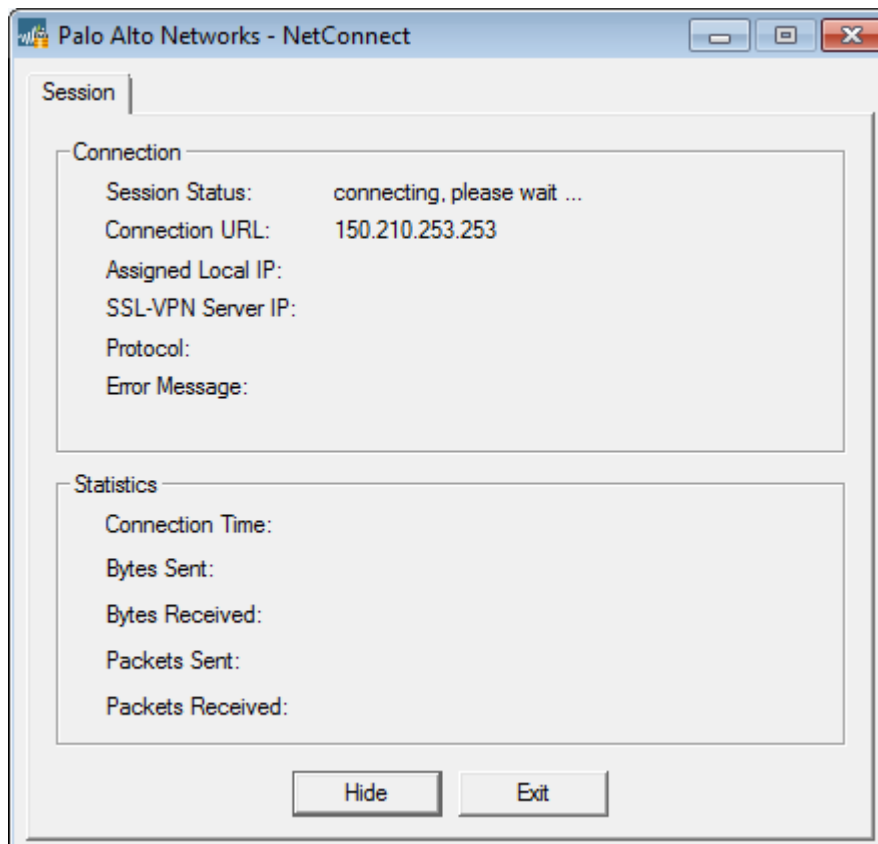
Step 10: The installation will continue and a dialogue box similar to the one below will appear on the screen. No user action is required.



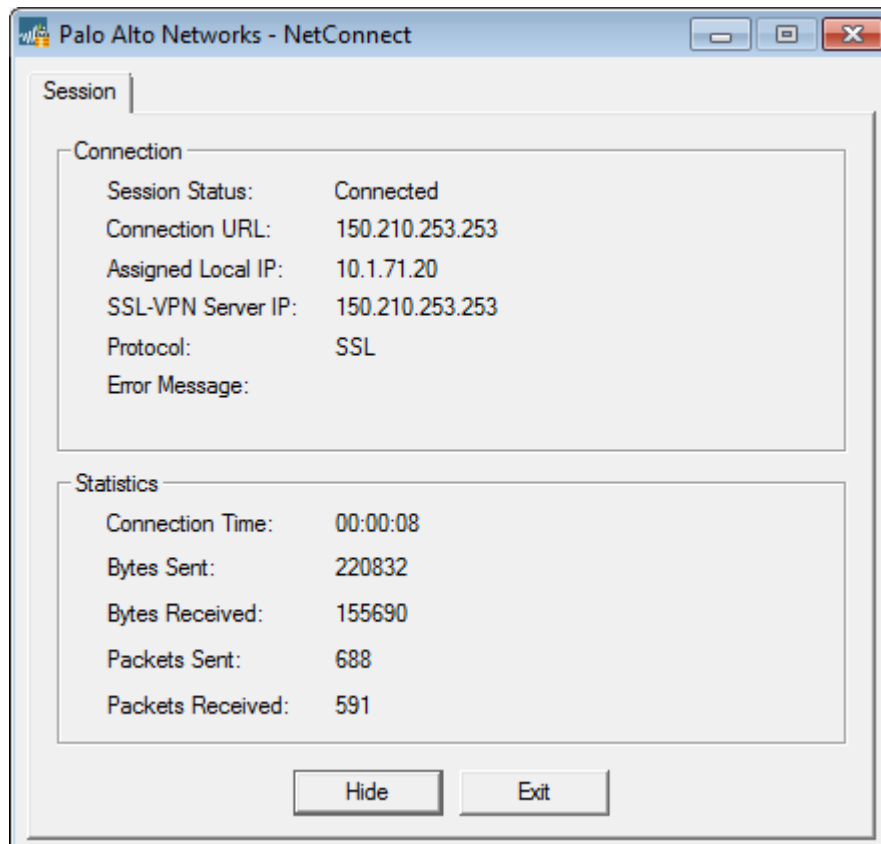
Step 11: Additional dialogue boxes will appear on the screen during the installation. No user action is required.



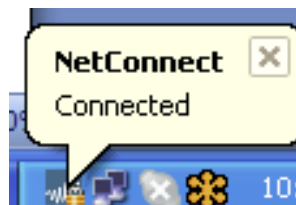
Step 12: Once the installation is complete, the Palo Alto Networks—Net Connect screen will appear and will automatically attempt to connect.



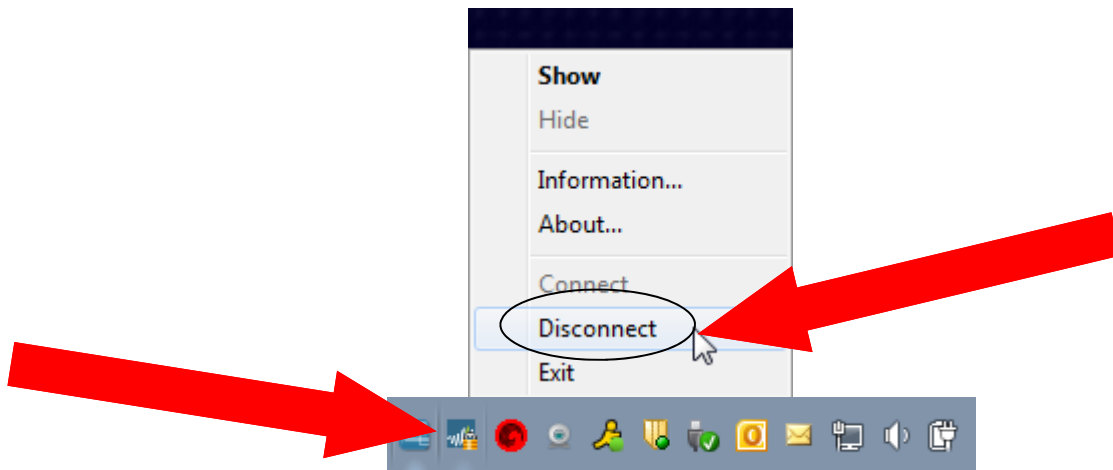
Step 13: Once you have successfully connected to the Firewall , the NetConnect window will appear and look similar to the example below showing you are connected.



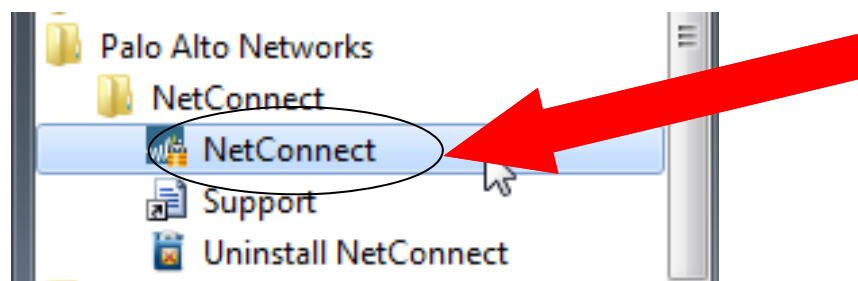
Step 14: Located in the bottom right hand corner of your screen, you will see an icon with the NetConnect logo and indicating you are connected.



Step 15: To disconnect from the VPN, right click the NetConnect button in the bottom right hand corner of screen in your menu bar and when prompted with a menu, click on disconnect as shown below. Within a few seconds of disconnecting, the icon will disappear from your menu bar.



Step 16: To connect to the VPN , click on the start button in the bottom left hand corner of your screen, click on Program or All programs and click on Palo Alto Networks. Within this folder, click on NetConnect



Step 17: Once the NetConnect program has launched, you will be prompted to enter your username with the domain first in the name field as shown below.

(e.g. bctc\bbaruch or acad\bbaruch

Step 18: Enter your password in the password field.

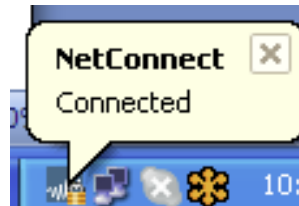
