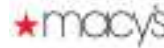

The Rising Starr Sophomore (RSS) Program

The Rising Starr Sophomore (RSS) Program will prepare students for work and leadership roles by providing a set of interdisciplinary, structured on and off campus learning experiences culminating in the award of a certificate.

There are required activities and/or events for each academic year along with suggested electives which allows students' to customize the program to suit their individual interests and needs.
