Coordinated the academic review of institutions seeking degree-granting authority for the first time in the State. Assisted in developing academic standards and policies for the Board of Regents, supervised site reviews of program quality at 40-50 institutions each year, advised colleges on the interpretation and enforcement of quality standards, and served as the Regents' liaison to the Middle States Association.
