THINGS TO TAKE NOTE OF

General Notes

- All Weissman School of Arts and Science majors require completion of at least 90 credits of liberal arts courses
- Your major must be at least 24 credits
- **Be sure to consult with your faculty advisor regarding specific major requirements**
- You must complete a liberal arts minor as part of the College Option requirement to graduate
- You must maintain a 2.0 Baruch GPA in order to remain in Good Academic Standing. You must also maintain a 2.0 major GPA in order to graduate
- FYS 1000 (First Year Seminar) is a required course for all students who entered as new freshmen. Transfer students are not required to take this course.

Notes about the Major

- Baruch offers a 25-credit BA major in Psychology. **This includes one required course in research methods, 12 credits of foundation courses, and 9 credits of electives.**
- **You are required to meet with a faculty advisor in psychology to declare a major.** The faculty advisor will discuss with you the foundations and elective courses that best meet your career goals. The Psychology Department is located in VC 8-215.
- * Students may not take both PSY 3059 and PSY 3060 to fulfill the core requirement.
