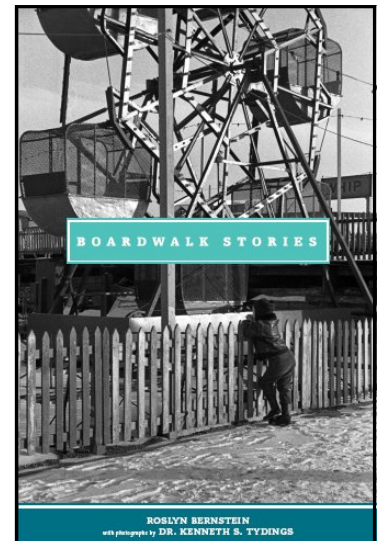

Meet the Neighbors: Roslyn Bernstein, author of Boardwalk Stories

Soho resident and boardwalk aficionado Roslyn Bernstein will read and share images from her new book, *Boardwalk Stories*.

Each story in the collection is paired with a vintage black-and-white boardwalk photograph capturing the mood after World War II, when a day out meant breathing in the bracing salt air and feeding coins into machines at the penny arcade.

ABOUT THE AUTHOR: Born in Brooklyn, Roslyn Bernstein moved to Long Beach, New York in 1948. She was raised in the West End of town, a short walking distance from the city's boardwalk. A poet and journalist, she has been a professor of Journalism and Creative Writing at Baruch College, CUNY, since 1974.
