- You can make changes to some of the data on your record. The changes are limited so please see below for more details.

Need to make changes to your directory entry? Follow these simple instructions.

1. Click the "Directory" link found on the header of the College's web site or visit <https://www.baruch.cuny.edu/directory>

3. Enter your Baruch Username and Password, then click **Log in**

4. Click "Edit" button on the bottom of the page to begin making changes.
