DECLARATION OF LIBERAL ARTS MINOR

The liberal arts minor (for the College Option of the Pathways Curriculum or for Tier III of the Baruch Common Core Curriculum) consists of three courses (at least 9 credits) in one of the departments or interdisciplinary programs in the Weissman School of Arts and Sciences or in certain approved programs. These courses must be chosen from a discipline outside of your major and from courses at the 3000-level or above. The minor must also include one Capstone course at the 4000-level or above, which must be completed at Baruch.

Pathways Curriculum: There is no GPA requirement for College Option courses, but in order to graduate with the liberal arts minor, a student must have a grade point average of at least 2.00 in the three courses that make up his or her minor.

Baruch Common Core: In order to graduate, a student must have a grade point average of at least 2.00 in the three courses that make up his or her liberal arts minor.
