Project Timeline



The Campus Plan creation process will be conducted in four phases:

- **Information Gathering and Needs Assessment** Spring–Summer 2025
- **Vision and Priorities** Fall–Winter 2025
- **Strategies and Alternatives** Winter–Spring 2025/2026
- **Baruch College Campus Plan** Summer 2026
